



GPS CAN'T FIND MY ADDRESS

Pinal County assigns and maintains an address database for anything needing an address in the County. Commercial companies that supply information to GPS tracking device collect their addresses independently. Pinal County has no association with these companies.

When the information on a GPS tracking device or a commercial web site is incorrect or missing, you can request they take a look. These are the web sites where you can make that request. Sites like Bing, Yahoo and Mapquest use one of these three sites.
