### ADDENDUM 1

The purpose of this addendum is to answer questions asked in writing that were received prior to the deadline.

### QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- 1) Q: Is the County and the Sheriff's Office able to accept an evaluation unit provided by the manufacturer to be returned after a trial period at no charge to the County?  
  
A: **No the evaluation will include a demonstration for those vendors who make the "short list". If you are invited to perform a demonstration there shall be no additional cost to the county.**
  
- 2) Q: Regarding requirement A-22 on page 7. What Brand/Model is the Pinal County/DPS Network Date-Radio to verify compatibility?  
  
A: **Gemini PD+**
  
- 3) Q: Will the County Sheriff's Office require installation?  
  
A: **Pinal County has not yet determined how installations will be accomplished. If this option is available, a separate cost per unit may be offered.**
  
- 4) Q: Is there any special consideration for Service Disabled Veteran Owned Companies?  
  
A: **No**
  
- 5) Q: Requirement A-7 states Detachable Key board with various mounting configurations". Requirement B-2 states "all in one design". Can you clarify these requirements?



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A: A-7 requires that the Keyboard should be detached from the Unit or the Screen and be available to be mounted in various configurations. B-2 is an optional item that the entire device (not including keyboard) be configured as a single all-in-one unit.

6) Q: Requirement B-9 asks for “irewire 400/800 ports”. Firewire is an obsolete I/O format and has not been included in recent computer designs for that reason. Will USB 2.0, LAN, serial or other up to date formats meet this requirement?

A: Several Vehicle Camera video systems still utilize Firewire and external storage devices. The County prefers this if available.

7): Q: Please provide detailed description of vehicles: year, make, and model. console and seat configurations for each vehicle if possible.  
(See related questions 3 & 16)

A: The current vehicle inventory is listed below, but may change prior to award. Pricing must be offered that will apply regardless of the type of vehicle in which unit will be installed.

8): Q: Is in-dash mounting configuration required or preferable for all vehicles including SUVs.?

A: Per B-1, this is not required, but optional & desirable, if available.

9): Q: Can you specify what connectivity is required for "DPS data radio compatibility" (req A22)?

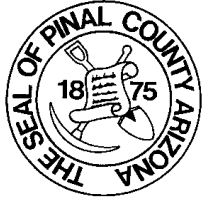

10): Q: The RFP is unclear as to the purchasing quantities for the first contract year Sept. 2, 2009 through Sept. 1 2010. Is it the Sheriff's Office expectation to replace out all existing system (228 units) in the first year and/or can a purchasing timeline be provided?

A: Purchase quantities will be determined based on available funding. The County is unable to definitively state the amount of funding it will have available for this purpose and as such. Vendor should adhere to the RFP and provide pricing in various unit amounts shown on page 9.

11): Q: Is the training of 8 Pinal County staff for IT or fleet maintenance and/or both?

A: This is a combined number, Fleet and IT



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12): Q: Does the County of Pinal pay sales tax or is the County tax-exempt?

A: Pinal County is not tax exempt and does pay sales tax. Do not include sales tax in your unit pricing on page 9, but list it as separate cost on the itemized cost breakdown.

13) Q: What Data-Radio is currently being employed and how are these interacting with the computer?

A: Gemini PD+ hooked to the PC or Dock via Serial Cable.

14): Q: What component parts are expected to be hot-swappable?

A: List any hot-swappable parts such as Motherboards, Hard Drives, KeyBoards, etc.

15): Q: If a vendor has not yet had a chance to demo their solution to Pinal County will they be given the chance prior to final selection? Or will Pinal County be short listing a group of qualified vendors for this...and, if so, what are the qualifying criteria for being short listed?

A: Please refer to the evaluation & selection criteria on page 14. Pinal County reserves the right to invite selected vendors to participate in demonstrations or presentation based on their ranking from the evaluation criteria at this time, without an accurate count on the number of respondents, Pinal County cannot make a determination on the number of offerors that will be invited to participate in the demonstration or presentations.

16): Q: How can we make an appointment to inspect vehicles for details needed to quote installation. (See related questions 3 & 7)

A: See answer #7, where general vehicle information, is provided Installation is not required but maybe quoted as a separate option.
