

The 3M Cloud Library app connects your Kindle Fire to PCLDs e-Book Library



Step 2: Download the 3M Cloud Library app

Tap on *Web* located on the home screen of your Kindle Fire.

Enter slideme.org then tap *Go*.

Log in or create an account by tapping on *Register*.

Once you have entered all of the required fields tap *Create new account*.

Open the email from SlideMe and write down your password.

Return to SlideMe and Log in.

In their Application search box type: 3m cloud. Tap *Go*.

Tap *Download* and respond OK when prompted.



Step 3: Install the app and Register

When the download is complete, go to your File Manager and look for the Download folder. Tap the 3M Cloud Library app then *Install*.

When the application installed message appears, tap *Open* at the bottom of the screen.

Agree to the SlideMe Application End User Agreement.

Again, tap *Install* at the bottom of the screen.

When the 3M Cloud Library welcome app appears, tap the *Launch* button. Then tap the *Connect to your library* button.

Select your Country, Your State, then your Library (Pinal County Library).


Enter your all 14 digits of your library card number with no spaces then your PIN, which is usually the last 4 digits of the phone number you provided on your library card application. Contact your local library if you need your PIN reset.

You're Done! Now you can check-out the library's eBooks on your Kindle Fire

Before installing the 3M Cloud Library app on your Kindle Fire, you will need a file manager app, from the Amazon AppStore for Android, such as "ES File Explorer" This will allow 3rd party applications, to be installed on your Kindle Fire. The steps are the same for most file managers.

The first step is to allow your Kindle Fire  to install 3rd party applications. Depending on which Kindle Fire you have, you will need to tap the *Gear Icon* located at the top of the screen, OR place your finger at the very top of the screen and drag down to show the Menu.

Tap the *More* button then scroll down until you find *Device*. Tap *Device* then turn on "Allow Installation of Applications"



Go back to your home screen by tapping the arrow at the bottom of the screen.
