



3M Cloud Library & Other eReaders

The Pinal County Library District offers the 3M Cloud Library as a resource for eBooks for eReaders such as the Sony Reader, Nook, and Kobo (*not Kindle*). In order to check out any 3M Cloud Library eBook, you will need a PCLD library card in good standing. You can check out up to three titles simultaneously for up to three weeks each and can place holds on up to three titles at a time. You will need to download the 3M app to your computer first. Then browse, check out, and read eBook titles all from within the Windows PC app.

TO PREPARE, DO THESE STEPS ...

The first step is to download the app for Windows PC. You can get this free software by going to the 3M Cloud Library webpage at <http://ebook.3m.com/> or search the web for “3M Cloud Library”. Once on the 3M Cloud Library Portal site, click on the Windows icon and follow the prompts to download the app. 3M is currently working on an app for Mac but it’s not available at this time. First Time Logging In?

1. Select State/County
2. Select Library
3. Enter Your Library Card # & PIN #
4. Read & Accept License Agreement
5. Select Login & Start Browsing

How To Get Free eBooks Onto Other eReaders

Step One:

Open the 3M Cloud Library app on your computer.

The first time you open the app you will be prompted to log-in by selecting your state, your library and type in your library barcode number and PIN number.

If you already use the software program Adobe Digital Editions to download eBooks from another service, 3M Cloud Library should automatically detect and use the same Adobe ID you used to authenticate that program.



If Adobe Digital Editions is not already installed and registered, or 3M Cloud Library does not detect your Adobe ID, it will give you two options: Use a 3M Cloud ID (no sign-in required, other than your library card and PIN) or enter an Adobe ID and Password.


The simplest way to proceed is to let 3M Cloud Library handle the authentication, and skip the process of creating or remembering an Adobe ID and password.

But! If you intend to transfer both 3M Cloud Library eBooks and other eBooks from another service to a (non-Kindle) eReader, you should authenticate your 3M Cloud Library app using your Adobe ID and password. Otherwise your eReader will only work with one service at a time.

Step Two:

Browse and select the book you'd like to checkout. You can click Shelves or Categories to browse for titles or use the Search feature to find specific titles.

When you have found a book, click the cover and then click the Check Out button.



Step Three:

To transfer titles to an eReader such as the Sony Reader, Nook or Kobo (*not Kindle*), connect your device to your computer with a USB cable after checking out a title.

Click on "My Books" and you will see a green "download to device" banner next to each checked out title. Click the green banner and the title is transferred to your device. A dialog box will tell you when your eBook has been successfully transferred to your device.

Safely eject your device and look in the Digital Editions folder for the title.

FAQs:

I transferred my library eBooks to my eReader – where are they?

Depending on your model of eReader, your 3M Cloud Library eBook may be loaded into the eReader's "library" (with all of your other books) or into a "documents" folder for sideloaded content.
