Interstate 10: Picacho Peak Road to Pinal Air Park Road
Traffic Alert for Sept. 27 – Oct. 2, 2009

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is scheduling the following restrictions as part of the Interstate 10 widening between Picacho Peak Road and Pinal Air Park Road. Please note that traffic control devices may be set up early, but restrictions will occur as scheduled.

Westbound I-10

- From 7 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. the following morning, from Sunday, Sept. 27, through Thursday, Oct. 1, lane closures are scheduled from milepost 232 to milepost 218 for rubberized asphalt paving. One lane will remain open at all times.
- The speed limit has been reduced to 55 mph from milepost 218 to milepost 213 during nighttime roadwork. Motorists are advised to please be alert to the speed limit and posted signs while driving through the construction zone

Westbound entrance and exit ramp closure for Red Rock Road (MP 226)

- From 7 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. the following morning on Tuesday, Sept. 29, and Wednesday, Sept. 30, the westbound exit and entrance ramps are scheduled for closure for rubberized asphalt paving.
 - I-10 westbound motorists: use Marana Road, exit 236. Turn left (south) on the frontage road and follow approximately seven miles to the Red Rock overpass. Turn left and cross over the interstate onto Sasco Road.

Westbound entrance and exit ramp closure for Picacho Peak Road (MP 219)

- From 7 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. the following morning on Wednesday, Sept. 30, and Thursday, Oct. 1, the westbound exit and entrance ramp are scheduled for closure for rubberized asphalt paving.
 - I-10 westbound motorists: use Red Rock Road, exit 226. Turn left (south) on the frontage road and follow approximately seven miles to Picacho Peak Road.

Eastbound I-10

- From 7 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 1 to 6 a.m. the following morning, milepost 232 to milepost 218 lane closures are scheduled for rubberized asphalt paving. One lane will remain open at all times.

Please note: Changes to construction plans can happen frequently due to weather, equipment availability and personnel issues. We try to anticipate construction activities a week in advance, but changes may occur. Intermittent lane closures, with short delays, may not always be known in advance.
