Pinal County Environmental Health Services is continuing our process of updating the Pinal County Sanitary Code, which has been in place since 1987. We are pleased to inform you that the Pinal County Environmental Health Code (PCEHC) has been drafted. The PCEHC provides guidance and regulations to help promote a safe and healthy environment for the citizens of Pinal County. While the code provisions are changing, there are no fee changes included in this revision. The code contains several chapters, including: General Provisions, Food Code, Aquatic Health Code, Manufactured Home and RV Parks, Schools, Camps and Campgrounds, Hotels and Motels, Rodents, Insects, and Vermin, Animals, Garbage, Rubbish and Refuse, and On-Site Wastewater Treatment Facilities.

We have scheduled a public meeting to discuss this revision and answer any questions you may have. At this meeting, we will be discussing the complete revision of the code one chapter at a time. We hope to see you at the meeting.
