### AFFIDAVIT

#### KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS

I, the affiant S. D. Ellingsen, being first duly sworn, under oath depose and say:

1. That I am an authorized representative for USNP Agency Services (herein 'USNP').
2. That USNP has been granted two (2) unpatented mining claims, registered and issued by the United States Department of the Interior-Bureau of Land Management (herein 'BLM'), for which metes and bounds, GPS, and map info is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, and both claims may be properly described as:  

A twenty (20) acre parcel of federal land in Pinal County, Arizona, located within the W½ of the NW¼ of Section 17, Range 16E, Township 10S, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian; registered with BLM under two federal mining claim serial numbers as follows: AMC384814 (*Crazy Cody lode*), and AMC385599 (*Campo Cody placer*).
3. That the above mining claims are coincident upon the land, one being a lode claim and the other a placer claim, and each claim has been recorded with the Pinal County Recorder's Office under the following fee numbers: 2007-100841, Crazy Cody lode; and 2007-102170, Campo Cody placer.
4. That John J. Assini (7493 N. Oracle Rd., #213, Tucson, Arizona 85704) has no authority and no affiliation whatsoever with USNP or its agents, and no interest in any USNP properties.
5. That John J. Assini neither requested nor received permission to enter upon USNP claims.
6. That John J. Assini, identified as locator and claimant of a 'Pima Joe' location, by way of his recorded location notice for a *Pima Joe lode mining claim* (herein 'PIMA JOE') is hereby served due notice that the statements, facts, and exhibits presented in this affidavit declare and demonstrate PIMA JOE is not a legal mining claim; and any subsequent assertion of such mineral rights, property interest, or existence of PIMA JOE or a similar location is, for all intents and purposes, null and void.
7. That no discovery monument and no location notice was posted in the vicinity indicated on the PIMA JOE location notice recorded in Pinal County, Arizona, as required by ARS §§ 27-202 and 203.
