Queen Creek, AZ—We have good news, the Empire Boulevard and Meridian Road/ Gary Road Intersection Improvement Project is nearly complete. Soon your community will benefit from new traffic signal equipment, pole foundations, poles, mast arms and signal heads to improve safety, reduce congestion, reduce maintenance costs, and improve traffic flow. Additional improvements included installation of left-turn lanes in all four directions and new pavement, gutter and curbing at the north and west legs of the intersection to match existing lane configuration and improvements at the south and east intersection legs. The Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) contractor will be onsite performing final construction activities and adjacent drainage channel improvements through the end of November 2014.

Thank you for your assistance and cooperation during this improvement effort.

Construction Work Hours

6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, weather permitting. Some evening and weekend work may be required.

Traffic Restrictions

During the upgrade process, traffic lane restrictions can be anticipated on Empire Boulevard and Meridian Road/Gary Road in the project vicinity. Please drive cautiously and be alert to changes in temporary construction signs and flag persons when driving through the construction zone. In addition, give yourself plenty of time to get where you are going as there may be traffic delays. Access will be maintained for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles at all times.

Safety Matters


