

Submit input and suggestions for the Regionally Significant Routes for Safety and Mobility (RSRSM) Update

Purpose for updating the Pinal County RSRSM map:

- The Pinal County Community Development Department uses the RSRSM's preservation map and access management manual on development to preserve, implement and fund Regionally Significant Routes.
- Define a process of an updatable preservation map to account for newly adopted transportation plans.
- Need to provide input and direction in defining procedures on how to ensure Pinal County captures compatibility with other regional and local plans.

Need for Regionally Significant Routes:

- Pinal County has experienced unprecedented growth for several years. As of the 2000 Census, there were 179,727 people residing in the county. As of the 2010 Census, there were 375,770 people residing in the county. At this rate, many are projecting that the County population will ultimately grow to nearly two million residents in due time.
- Rapid increase in congestion is evident in parts of Pinal County. A continuous stream of traffic along SR 347, Sunland Gin Road/Battalia Drive, Ironwood Drive/Gantzel Road, and Hunt Highway are common sites during peak hours.
- Traffic accidents have significant impacts on transportation network. Frequent traffic accidents result in closed roads and traffic backups.
- Restricted road capacity, lack of continuity and connectivity between activity centers, cities/towns/Native American communities and State highway system.



3 Metropolitan Planning Organizations:

- 1 – MAG (Maricopa Association of Governments):
The area includes three American Indian Communities, and three counties which includes all of Maricopa county and parts of Pinal and Yavapai counties.
- 2 – CAG (Central Arizona Governments):
The area includes three American Indian Communities, and two counties which includes Gila and Pinal counties.
- 3 – Sun Corridor:
The area includes the communities of Casa Grande, Coolidge, Eloy an rural portions of Pinal County.

4 Types of Roads:

- 1 - Corridor:
A linear area that is defined by one or more modes of transportation like highways, railroads or public transit
- 2 - Arterial:
Delivers traffic from low to moderate capacity roads to freeways
- 3 - Freeway:
express highway with no intersections, usually having traffic routed on and off
- 4 - Parkway:
Open landscaped highway, intended for scenic and recreational driving
