PURPOSE




- To provide state-of-the-industry fire protection and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to areas in southeast Pinal County undesignated and underserved by fire districts
 - To enhance a long-suffering area which has limited resources

SERVICES PROVIDED



- Fire Protection and Suppression
 - Station 625 in Mammoth - Current
 - Station 626 – 1.3 miles east of AZ 77 on E. Aravaipa Canyon Rd – 2014
 - All volunteer Firefighters are AZ certified FFII's and either AZ EMTs or Paramedics
 - Graduates of the Pima College Fire Academy
 - Certified in HazMat Operations & Rope Rescue
 - Stand shifts at PRF&R Stations
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SERVICES PROVIDED



- Emergency Medical Services
- 70-80 % of Fire Department responses are EMS related today
 - PRF&R has 10 Certified EMTs *and* 4 Paramedics on active roster
 - Only Fire-Based Advanced Life Support EMS program in the entire Copper Corridor Region 24/7/365






SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

- Certificate of Necessity to Operate an Ambulance (CON) is applied for
 - Administratively Complete portion completed January 2014
 - Currently awaiting inspections and public hearing to prove public necessity





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SERVICES OFFERED



- Wildland Fire Protection and Suppression
 - Arizona Forestry Wildland Co-Operator
 - All PRF&R AZ certified Firefighter I/II's are also Wildland Certified FFT2s
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SERVICES PROVIDED



- All-Hazards Rescue Services
 - Work with local agency having SAR Responsibility (PCSO)
 - Certified Technical Rope Rescue Personnel
 - Certified HazMat Site-Incident Commander
 - HazMat TOXMEDIC response and medical oversight
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CASINO IMPACT

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 - The existing “Status Quo” system that has operated unchanged for decades is incapable of meeting the demand
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FIRE TRAINING FACILITY

- The proposed Fire Training Facility also meets CDBG parameters as a vocational training facility
 - Training Facility will be built to NFPA 1402, *Guide to Building Fire Service Training Centers*, and operated under NFPA 1403, *Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions*.
 - PRF&R has two staff IFSAC accredited Fire Instructors
 - Courses held will meet the requirements of AZFSCE for certification for Firefighter I/II and EMCTs
 - Facility can also be used by law enforcement for training
 - Will have 40' Tower for Ropes and Ladder evolution training

 - ❑ All EMS personnel are currently certified with the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians
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FIRE RESPONSE POLICY

- If much is to be saved much will be risked – *risk a lot to save a lot*
 - If little is to be saved little will be risked – *risk a little to save a little*
 - If nothing is to be saved nothing will be risked – *risk nothing to save nothing*
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FIRE RESPONSE POLICY

- ❑ PRF&R has NEVER refused to respond to any emergency in their Area of Operations (AO) because a residence or patient was not a subscriber
 - ❑ PRF&R has NEVER billed, *to date*, for *any fire response* in our AO to nonsubscribers
 - ❑ PRF&R DOES bill automotive insurance companies for MVA responses in their AO since PRF&R is not eligible for FDAT (Fire District Assistance Tax)
 - ❑ PRF&R is in the process of attempting to transition from 501(c)(3) to fire district status
 - This has been faced with much difficulty on the part of a Pinal County Department
