Pinal County Air Quality

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Air Quality Hearing Board

- **Formation Authority:** A.R.S. §49-478 - Mandatory
- **Membership:** Five members. The five members shall be knowledgeable in the field of air pollution. At least one member of the board shall be an attorney licensed to practice law in this state. At least three members shall not have a substantial interest, as defined in section 38-502, in any person required to obtain a permit pursuant to this article.
- **Term of Office:** Three years.
Powers: The Hearing Board considers appeals from contested administrative actions, namely air quality permits and orders of abatement issued by the Director/Control Officer.
- **Meeting Frequency:** As Required

Air Quality Hearing Board

Air Quality Advisory Council

- **Authority:** A.R.S. §49-477 (Non-Mandatory)
- **Membership:** Current form nine members
- **Term of Office:** Three years
- **Powers:** The board of supervisors *may* appoint an advisory council of such membership as it deems necessary to advise and consult with the Board of Supervisors, the control agency, and the control officer in effecting the purposes of this article.
- **Meeting Frequency:** Historically met annually or as needed

Air Quality Advisory Council

Status

- 5 of the 9 seats are currently filled
