Ms. Villarreal explained that there was a significant difference in taxes from the previous years as there is work that needs to be done on the piping. The required increase was spread over an eight year period.

Greg Stanley, County Manager, said that the long term plan is to abandon this District and have the City of Casa Grande take it over as they are currently treating the sewage.

Director Smith asked Mr. Stanley if the City of Casa Grande was in agreement with this approach and Mr. Stanley indicated they were.

Motion was made by Supervisor Smith and seconded by Supervisor Chase to approve Desert Vista Sanitary District Tentative Budget for fiscal year 2016-2017. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
