

RESOLUTION NO. 1330-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FLORENCE, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD RAIL YARD AND INDUSTRIAL PARK IN PINAL COUNTY.


WHEREAS, the Union Pacific Rail Road is pursuing plans for a 1,000-acre rail yard and industrial park in southern Pinal County; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that development of the rail yard and industrial park will provide significant economic development benefits to Pinal County and municipalities surrounding the project; and

WHEREAS the Town Council is supportive of assisting our regional partners in economic development efforts to recruit new businesses to Pinal County so our citizens may have access to a diverse employment opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FLORENCE, ARIZONA, that the Town of Florence hereby supports the development of a Union Pacific Railroad rail yard and industrial park in Pinal County, urges Union Pacific Railroad to equitably compensate property owners impacted by the project, urges that the project include rail spurs and other intermodal-transfer opportunities, and authorizes Town staff to take reasonable actions to support the project.


