

**MARANA RESOLUTION NO. 2012-03**

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD RAIL YARD AND INDUSTRIAL PARK IN PINAL COUNTY

WHEREAS the Union Pacific Railroad is pursuing plans for a 1,000-acre rail yard and industrial park in southern Pinal County; and


WHEREAS the Town Council finds that development of the rail yard and industrial park will provide significant economic development benefits to nearby communities, including the Town of Marana, particularly if the project includes rail spurs and other intermodal-transfer opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARANA, ARIZONA, that the Town of Marana hereby supports the development of a Union Pacific Railroad rail yard and industrial park in Pinal County, urges Union Pacific Railroad to equitably compensate property owners impacted by the project, urges that the project include rail spurs and other intermodal-transfer opportunities, and authorizes Town staff to take reasonable actions to support the project.


