DEFINITION OF POLITICAL COMMITTEE: A.R.S. §16-901(20) "Political Committee" means any of the following: (a) A candidate or a candidate's campaign committee; (b) A separate, segregated fund established pursuant to section 16-920, a subsection A, paragraph 3; (c) An association or combination of persons that circulates petitions in support of the qualification of a ballot measure, question or proposition; (d) An association or combination of persons that circulates a petition to recall a public officer; (e) A political party; (f) An association or combination of persons that meets both of the following requirements: (i) Is organized, conducted or combined for the primary purpose of influencing the result of any election in this state or in any county, city, town or other political subdivision in this state, including a judicial retention election, and (ii) Knowingly receives contributions or makes expenditures of more than five hundred dollars in connection with any election during a calendar year, including a judicial retention election; (g) A political organization; (h) An exploratory committee.

NOTE FOR INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: An individual, acting alone, is not a political committee under Arizona law and need not file a statement of organization. If any additional person or persons join the effort (as defined above in A.R.S. §16-901(20) begun by an individual, the association of persons has become "political committee" under Arizona law, and must file a statement of organization before accepting contributions, making expenditures exceeding \$500, distributing literature or circulating petitions. A.R.S. §16-902.01(A).

Candidates and political committees involved with statewide and legislative elections file this statement with the Secretary of State Election Services Division: 1700 W. Washington, 7th Floor, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Candidates and political committees involved with city or town elections file this statement with the city or town clerk. Candidates and political committees involved with school districts file this statement with the Pinal County School Superintendent's Office.
