2014 PRIMARY and GENERAL ELECTIONS

This candidate handout is published by the Pinal County Recorder's Office/Elections Department. The information is to assist qualified electors contemplating elective office in the 2014 Primary and General Elections. Pinal County prospective candidates must be qualified electors of the county, district or precinct in which the duties of the office are to be exercised.

PRIMARY ELECTION- AUGUST 26, 2014

Early Voting starts: July 31, 2014
Registration Closes: July 28, 2014 at Midnight

IMPORTANT: A Statement of Organization or a \$500 Threshold Exemption Statement must be filed **BEFORE** accepting contributions, making expenditures, distributing campaign literature or circulating petitions.

Filing Dates: **First Day to file** nomination paper, petitions & financial disclosure
April 28, 2014 **Last day to file** **May 28, 2014** not later than 5:00 P.M.!

GENERAL ELECTION- NOVEMBER 4, 2014

Early Voting starts: October 9, 2014
Registration Closes: October 6, 2014 at Midnight

Filing Dates: **First Day to file** nomination paper & petitions **July 7, 2014**
Last day to file **August 6, 2014** not later than 5:00 P.M.!

CANDIDATE PACKET

Packets are available containing candidate information, petitions and forms required to be filed with the Pinal County Elections Department. Prospective Pinal County Candidates, both for public office and for the party office of Precinct Committeemen **MUST FILE** a Statement of Organization **or** a \$500 Threshold Exemption Statement **BEFORE** circulating petitions.

***NEW** - Candidates must file either a Statement of Organization or \$500 Threshold Exemption Statement for **BOTH the Primary Election and General Election**. However, candidates that only appear on the General Election ballot do not need to file for the Primary Election.

Candidates file the required nomination forms and petitions with the Pinal County Elections Department in Florence. Candidate nominating procedures are covered in A.R.S. 16-301 through A.R.S. 16-351.

SCHOOL GOVERNING BOARDS

Central Arizona College Governing Board candidates file with Pinal County Elections Department. Candidates for School District Board Members file with the Pinal County School Superintendent's Office. For additional information or further assistance, school board candidates should call the Pinal County School Superintendent's Office at (520) 866-6565.

CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTING

Required financial reporting forms for prospective candidates are prescribed, prepared and printed by the Secretary of State (A.R.S. Title 16, Chapter 6). These forms are filed with the Pinal County Elections Department. If a candidate **RECEIVES or EXPENDS MORE THAN \$500.00**, the candidate must file a **Statement of Organization** with the Pinal County Elections Department within 5 days.

WRITE-IN CANDIDATES A.R.S. 16-312

Any qualified elector desiring to become a write-in candidate for an elective office in any election shall file a nomination paper not later than forty (40) days prior to the date of the election. For elections that are subject to cancellation (i.e. precinct committeemen and most special taxing district elections held pursuant to title 48), the filing deadline is not later than 76 days before the election. A candidate may not file as a Write-In if the candidate ran in the immediately preceding primary election and failed to be nominated to the office sought in the current election or filed a nomination petition for the immediately preceding primary election for the office sought and failed to provide a sufficient number of valid petition signatures.

Primary Write-In Candidates (precinct committeemen) filing deadline:
June 11, 2014 - not later than 5:00 P.M.

Primary Write-In Candidates (for elections not subject to cancellation) filing deadline:
July 17, 2014 - not later than 5:00 P.M.

General Write-In Candidates (for elections subject to cancellation) filing deadline:
August 20, 2014 - not later than 5:00 P.M.

General Write-In Candidates filing deadline:
September 25, 2014 - not later than 5:00 P.M.
